



Things To Prepare :

- A hand polishing tool with [variable speed](#)
- A few pieces of clean cloth
- A bottle of water with sprayer
- One number of Red Polishing Pads
- A small pail of water

Polishing Procedures:

Step1: Attached a pad holder to the polishing machine.

Put Velco tape to the pad holder if it is a rubber holder.



Step2:

Attached the red polishing pad to the velco pad holder.



Step3: Put half teaspoon of **SCL-Marble Polishing Powder** onto the etched or dull area. This amount of powder can cover area of 2 palms size.



Things to Avoid when polishing with Marble Powder.

- Do not over polish with **SCL-Marble Polishing Powder**. It will result an orange peel look.
- Do not wet the marble powder if you are not ready to start the polishing. If you have sprayed too much water to the marble powder and you could not polish the powder to dry after 3 minutes, pick up the slurry immediately with a damp cloth.
- Dry the floor and check the shine. If etched mark or dull spot remains, spray a few drop of water to the pad again and polish a few more circular motion and stop.

Polishing Tips:

- Put some damp cloth to surround the area that need the polishing. This will prevent slurry splashes to other area during polishing.
- Do not put cloth too near the dull area as you may accidentally coil the cloth to the polishing machine during polishing. **STOP** the machine immediately if this happens.

Recommendations:

- Always test the marble polishing powder on a small area(a palm size) before working on a big area. Work on a small area until you are familiar with the product.
- Deeply scratched surfaces need professional restoration.
- A hand drill machine or a hand polishing machine with adjustable speed is necessary to achieve good result.

Caution: DO NOT leave the powder dry on the marble surface.

Step 4: Adjust the machine to the slowest speed before you start the machine.

Step 5:

Spray a few drop of water to the powder



Step 6: Place the machine on top of the powder. Begin the polishing. Polish in a circular motion for about 1 to 2 minutes, the powder will become a slurry. If the powder gets too dry, immediately stop the machine and spray a little more water to the pad. Continue the polishing. You can also polish from left to right motion 12 times(approx.2 minutes). Polish the slurry to almost dry. Wipe off the slurry with a damp cloth. Dry the floor and check if the dull spot is removed. Repeat the polishing for another 1 minute if dull spot remains.

Step 7: Immediately wipe off all the slurry when the desired shine is attained.

Step 8: Thereafter, rinse the floor with **SCL-STONEMIST** (ready-to-use) to remove all remaining powder residues on the marble surface.
